

Dear Parents,

The Code of Iowa requires that parents provide signed consent/authorization for the administration of medicine to students. It also requires that medicines come to school in pharmacy-provided containers with the dosage, time, instructions for administration, and the child's name on it.

All medicine is to be kept in the building offices where the child will come to receive it.

The person administering the medicine must initial and record the date and time on the administration record. The person administering the medicine must see it consumed.

Over-the-counter medication, including aspirin, cough drops, etc., must have the same authorization as prescription medicine, that is, dosage, instructions and container with name, etc.

If you send medicine to school for your child, please complete the authorization form and send it with the medicine. If you need more forms, or have further questions, please call the school.
